Hybrid Instruction will be a combination of online assignments, teacher videos, and paper tasks to support student development and academic success. It is our goal to partner with you and your student(s) to continue providing the best instructional opportunities. We appreciate your support during this time.

A few reminders:

- STAAR and EOC testing has been cancelled for this year.
- Lunches will be available at the Middle School 11:00-12:30 Monday through Friday. (Students must be present for lunch pick up.)
- Buses will follow their normal routes to deliver lunches beginning Monday starting at 11:00 AM. Students can meet the bus driver at their routine pick up location.

Assignments and Instruction:

- Instructional packets / assignments will be in the Google Classroom (6th - 12th) or emailed to the parent for printing. Instructional packets can be delivered and returned on the Monday bus routes. Please email questions@cmisd.org if you need a packet delivered.

Beginning the week of March 23rd:

PreK - 3rd Grade: Paper packets of lessons and assignments and some online activities.

- Your child's homeroom teacher will provide more details regarding grade level Hybrid Instruction.

4th - 5th Grade: Combination of online and paper assignments.

- Your child's homeroom teacher will provide more details regarding grade level Hybrid Instruction.

6th - 12th Grade: Lessons and assignments will continue to be online in Google Classroom. Paper packets will be available for those that do not have internet access.

- Students will receive detailed instructions for assignments in Google Classroom from their teachers.

Additional Resources for Parents and Students

CMISD has created a list of additional age appropriate resources that may be helpful to support your child's academic skills. You may want to consider a daily schedule for your child(ren), as a way to establish and maintain structure and routines.

Elementary Students:

PreK-1st Grades:

Literacy Skills (15 - 20 minutes daily)

- Practice letter names and letter sounds
- Practice chunks or rhyming words
- Read books together and discuss the characters, setting, and story

Math Skills (15 - 20 Minutes daily)

- Practice number recognition and counting
- Make patterns with household objects (ABA, AABB, ABC)

Writing (15 - 20 Minutes daily)

- Practice writing name or sentences, draw a picture and write a sentence or story about the picture
