

## **EXEMPTION POLICY**

The exemption policy pertains to Junior and Senior students in all subjects. The exemption policy applies to Freshmen and Sophomores in all classes except: Mathematics --- English --- Science --- Social Studies

Any student with two or less absences in a subject may be exempt if the student's average is an 80 or higher. If a student is absent four times or less the student's average must be a 90 or higher. No student may be exempt with an unexcused absence or any time spent in ISS or AEP. No student may be exempt with any missing/overdue library books or school equipment.

Students will be encouraged to take all semester exams. Any student qualified for exemption may take semester exams for the purpose of improving the overall average. If a student chooses to take an exam although they are exempt, the exam will not lower the overall average of the student's grade. If a student owes any outstanding fines (library, athletic, fundraiser, etc.) or textbooks at the time of exemptions, the student will not be allowed to be exempt.

***Any student who is absent during the exam week will require a doctor's note in order to receive an excused absence. If we do not receive a doctor's note, the student will be required to take all exams for that day next semester. A parent note will not be acceptable in keeping exemptions.***
